Our privacy policy is governed by the New Zealand Privacy Act 1993.

Website analytics

On this website we use web measurement tools to collect statistical information about your visit. We use this information to help us understand how people are using www.swa.govt.nz and to improve the site. These tools do not identify the individuals using the site. We can see a record of what people do on the site, but not who they are.

The information we collect includes:

- Your IP address
- The search terms you used
- The pages accessed on our site and the links you clicked on
- The date and time you visited the site
- The referring site (if any) through which you clicked through to this site
- Your operating system (eg Windows XP, Mac OS X) The type of web browser you use (eg Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Chrome)

Cookies

Our site uses temporary cookies. Browser or 'web' cookies are small text files that are sent by a website and stored on your computer's hard drive. These cookies do not collect any personal data and are deleted when you close your browser.

You can manually disable cookies at any time – check your browser's 'Help' to find out how. Disabling cookies will not affect your ability to use this website.

Google Analytics

We do not use cookies to gather any personally identifiable information. We use cookies to gather data about trends in site usage using a tool called Google Analytics.
