

Community Insights Explorer

The Social Wellbeing Agency has developed a new explorer tool to assist with the response and recovery from adverse weather events.

The need to have social and demographic data about communities increased following the adverse weather events that impacted communities across the North Island in early 2023.

Following these events and to support communities as they recover, we have developed a [data explorer](#) to bring a range of information together for decision-makers. This explorer is not intended to provide all the answers – but we hope it will help us to ask better questions.

Given the importance of understanding wellbeing alongside the impact of recent weather events, we have also partnered with Dragonfly Data Science to understand – from satellite data – the impact of Cyclone Gabrielle for the East Coast.
